One Week Look Ahead

The Exhibit Pool was drained this week and the Owner Punch work created and worked off. The Exhibit Pool is being cleaned and flushed; with preparations being made, for the final fill scheduled for Saturday mid morning. The pool fill should be completed Saturday evening, with calculations for volume starting with the Holding and Quarantine Pools.

The Hard and Softscape work is progressing around the Site working toward the original Construction Entrance between the LSS and Bird Buildings.

Commissioning for the Life Support Systems is scheduled for next week upon completion of the final pool fill. Ted Maranda to be on Site 3/7 and 3/8; returning on 3/17 and 3/18 for the Ozone Systems Commissioning.
